




Brief Note



Cources and their syllabus:

MSc Animal Biology and Biotechnology:

The curriculum of the course has a mix of basic and modern aspects of Biology and Biotechnology. The four-semester program is comprised of core courses in the first two semesters followed by elective courses during the third and fourth semesters. The core courses offer an in-depth knowledge in Evolutionary Biology, Biochemistry, Microbiology, Cell Biology, Molecular Biology, Mammalian Physiology, Developmental Biology, Enzymology and Intermediary Metabolism, Genetics, Endocrinology and Reproductive Biology, Immunology, Stem Cell Biology and Transgenic Technology. These jobs are abundant in any part of the world. You can go work as a research analysict or as a chemist in a chemical company and in various other companies.

Many organic food producting companies and other companies who produce beverages and milk products and also the fodder and seeds all will need the people who studied life sciences. So study hard.



PART 'A' CORE

UNIT-I

Mathematical Methods of Physics Dimensional analysis

Vector algebra and vector calculus. Linear algebra, matrices, Cayley-Hamilton Theorem.

Eigen values and eigenvectors. Linear ordinary differential equations of first & second order, Special functions (Hermit, Bessel, Laguerre and Legendre functions). Fourier series, Fourier and Laplace transforms. Elements of complex analysis, analytic functions; Taylor & Laurent series; poles, residues and evaluation of integrals. Elementary probability theory, random variables, binomial, Poisson and normal distributions. Central limit theorem.

UNIT-II

Classical Mechanics Newton's laws.

Dynamical systems, Phase space dynamics, stability analysis. Central force motions.

Two body Collisions - scattering in laboratory and Centre of mass frames. Rigid body dynamics moment of inertia tensor. Non-inertial frames and pseudo forces. Variational principle. Generalized coordinates. Lagrangian and Hamiltonian formalism and equations of motion. Conservation laws and cyclic coordinates. Periodic motion: small oscillations, normal modes. Special theory of relativity Lorentz transformations, relativistic kinematics and mass—energy equivalence.

UNIT-III

Electromagnetic Theory Electrostatics

Gauss's law and its applications, Laplace and Poisson equations, boundary value problems. Magneto statics: Biot-Savart law, Ampere's theorem. Electromagnetic induction. Maxwell's equations in free space and linear isotropic media; boundary conditions on the fields at interfaces. Scalar and vector potentials, gauge invariance. Electromagnetic waves in free space. Dielectrics and conductors. Reflection and refraction, polarization, Fresnel's law, interference, coherence, and diffraction. Dynamics of charged particles in static and uniform electromagnetic fields.

UNIT-IV

Quantum Mechanics

Wave-particle duality. Schrödinger equation (time-dependent and time-independent).

Eigen value problems (particle in a box, harmonic oscillator, etc.). Tunneling through a barrier. Wave-function in coordinate and momentum representations. Commentators and Heisenberg uncertainty principle. Dirac notation for state vectors. Motion in a central potential: orbital angular momentum, angular momentum algebra, spin, addition of angular moment; Hydrogen atom. Stern-Gerlach experiment. Time independent perturbation theory and applications. Variational method. Time dependent perturbation theory and Fermi's golden rule, selection rules. Identical particles, Pauli Exclusion Principle, spin-statistics connection.

UNIT-V

Thermodynamic and Statistical Physics

Laws of thermodynamics and their consequences. Thermodynamic potentials, Maxwell relations, chemical potential, phase equilibria. Phase space, micro- and macro-states.

Micro-canonical, canonical and grand-canonical ensembles and partition functions. Free energy and its connection with thermodynamic quantities. Classical and quantum statistics. Ideal Bose and Fermi gases. Principle of detailed balance. Blackbody radiation and Planck's distribution law.

UNIT-VI

Electronics and Experimental Methods

Semiconductor devices (diodes, junctions, transistors, field effect devices, homo- and hetero-junction devices), device structure, device characteristics, frequency dependence and applications. Opto-electronic devices (solar cells, photo-detectors, LEDs).

Operational amplifiers and their applications. Digital techniques and applications (registers, counters, comparators and similar circuits). A/D and D/A converters.

Microprocessor and microcontroller basics. Data interpretation and analysis. Precision and accuracy. Error analysis, propagation of errors. Least squares fitting,

Green's function. Partial differential equations (Laplace, wave and heat equations in two and three dimensions). Finite difference methods. Tensors. Introductory group theory: SU(2), O(3).

Transmission lines and wave guides. Radiation- from moving charges and dipoles and retarded potentials.

UNIT-IV

Quantum Mechanics:

Spin-orbit coupling, fine structure. WKB approximation. Elementary theory of scattering: phase shifts, partial waves, Born approximation. Relativistic quantum mechanics: Klein-Gordon and Dirac equations. Semi-classical theory of radiation.

UNIT-V

Thermodynamic and Statistical Physics:

First- and second-order phase transitions. Diamagnetism, paramagnetism, and ferromagnetism. Ising model. Bose-Einstein condensation. Diffusion equation. Random walk and Brownian motion. Introduction to no equilibrium processes.

Electronics and Experimental Methods:

స్టాటిస్టిక్ట్ గురించి ఈరోజున అందరికీ తెలుసు కాని 1900 [పాంతంలో ముఖ్యంగా మనదేశంలో పెద్దగా తెలియదు. ఈ గణాంకశాస్త్రం వికసించడానికి శ్రీకారం చుట్టినవారు ప్రశాంత చంద్రమహలనోజిస్. ప్రతి విషయాన్నీ స్టిటిస్టిక్ట్ ద్వారా అంచనా వేసి సమస్య ఏమిటో అవగాహన చేసుకుని ఖచ్చితమైన పరిష్కార మార్గాన్ని చూపడం మహలనోజిస్ (పొరంధించాడు.

శాంతినికేతన్లో విద్యాభ్యాసం చేసేవాలకి పడకలను ఏర్పాటు చేసేటప్పడు కూడా మహలనో జస్ స్టాటిస్టిక్స్ పాటించాడు. విద్యార్థుల సగటు ఎత్తు తీసుకుని ఆ ఎత్తుకు తగీనట్లు మంచాలు తయారు చేయించాడు. ఇంత చిన్నచిన్న విషయాల పట్ల కూడా ఈయన ఇలా ప్రవర్తించడం వల్ల కొంత మంచి ఈయనను కాంక్ అని పీలవడం మొదలు పెట్టారు. నిజంగా ఆలోచిస్తే మార్క్ ట్వయిన్ చెప్పిన నిర్వచనం ప్రకారం మహలనో జస్ కాంకే. విజయవంతమైన కొత్త ఆలోచనలు ఉన్నవాడు ఎవరైనా కాంకే అని మార్క్ట్ ట్వయిన్ అభిపాయం.

మాహలసోజాస్తోనే భారతదేశంలో స్వాటిస్మిక్క్ వాడకం మొదలైందని చెప్పినా అతిశయోక్తి కాబోదు. వాస్తవానికి మొదట్లో మహలనోజాస్కి స్టాటిస్టిక్ట్ అంటే పెద్దగా ఇష్టం ఉండేది కాదు. లండన్లోని కింగ్డ్ కణానాంతోని లైబ్రల్లో పుస్తకాలు చూస్తుంటే మహలనోజాస్కు గణితం కెప్పే మకాలే బయోమెటికికా అండ్ బయోమెటిక్ టేబుల్ట్ జర్మల్ వాల్యూమ్ను ఇచ్చి చదవమని చెప్పాడు. దాన్ని చదవడంతో మహంతోజోసకు ఎక్కడలేని కుతూహంలం కరిగింది.

1915లో మొదటి అప్పంచ యుద్ధం చెలరేగుతున్న సమయంలో మాహలనోజాస్ అండన్కు వెళ్ళకూడదని నిశ్చయించుకున్నాడు. ఫీజిక్స్ జి.ఎస్టీ చేసి కలకత్తులోని టెసిడెస్టీ కళాశాలలో భౌతిక శాస్త్ర కళ్యాపకుడిగా స్థిరపడ్డాడు. అయినా స్టాటిస్టిక్స్ మాత్రం మానలేదు. ఈయన కాలాన్నంతా వ్యర్థంగా గడుపుతున్నాడని ఎంతోముంది విమల్మంచేవారు కూడా! కాని రవీంద్రనాధ్ ఠాగూర్, బ్రజేంద్రనాధ్సీల్, నీలరతస్ సర్కార్ వంటి మేధావులు మాత్రం మహలనోజాస్ను ఎంతగానో టాత్సహించేవారు 1917 లో కలకత్తా విశ్వవిధ్యాలయంలోని పలీక్షల వ్యవస్థను సంస్కలంచవలసిందిగా పీల్ మహలనోజాస్ను కోరాడు. మహలనోజస్ స్టాటిస్టిక్స్ అదాతంగా ఎంతో విలువైన సూచనలను చేశాడు. సీల్ వాటిని అమోదించాడు. వాటి ప్రభావం చూచి చాలా మంది ఆశ్వర్మపోయారు.

మహలనోజిస్ ఆంత్రోపీలజ, ఎపీడిమియాలజ, డిమ్మోగఫీ మెటీలయాలజముదలైన శాంత్రీలలో స్టిటిస్టిక్ట్ ను వినియోంగించడం మొదలుపెట్టాడు. ఉష్ణో గ్రశ్. పీడనం, తేమశాతం ఇలాంటి అంశాలను గణాంక శాస్త్రల్కి తెలుపుతూ వాస్తవ పరిస్థితులను స్వష్టం చేసేవాడు. 1922లో కెంగాల్లో వరదలు రాకుండా ఎత్తైన ఆనకట్టలు కట్టాలని ఇంజనీశ్లు సూచించగా - యాబై పేక్క \$50,0 ₹0650x ₹1250x 1
